Driving Directions to the Priory Campus

From Downtown:

- Take I-290 West to Harlem Avenue (Exit 21B) NOTE: This exit is on the LEFT side of the expressway.
- Turn right (north) on Harlem Avenue to Division
- Turn left on Division.
- Dominican's Priory Campus will be on your right.

From the North:

- Take I-294 South to I-90 East
- Exit on Harlem Avenue (Exit 81A)
- Turn right (south) on Harlem Avenue (for approximately 5 miles) to Division.
- Turn right (west) on Division.
- Dominican – Priory Campus will be on your right.

From the Southwest:

- Take I-55 North to I-294. From the west
- Take I-290 East to Harlem Avenue (Exit 21B) NOTE: This exit is on the LEFT side of the expressway.
- Turn left (north) on Harlem Avenue to Division.
- Turn left on Division.
- Dominican's Priory Campus will be on your right.

Parking:

Head north through the gates, steer right and look for parking on the east side of the building.

Public Transit

From the CTA Green Line Harlem Avenue stop, or Metra Oak Park stop.

Then take one of these buses NORTH to the Division Street stop.

- The priory entrance is about 100 feet west of Division
- Walk north through the gates. When the road splits go toward the right and look for the entrance on the left.
